“KazTransOil” JSC informs about operational results for 2013 (non-consolidated)

The actual volume of oil transportation by “KazTransOil” JSC pipelines in 2013 amounted 53,924 thousand tons, which is 2,049 thousand tons (or 4%) higher than the plan and 465 thousand tons (or 1%) higher than in 2012.

The volume of oil transportation by “KazTransOil” JSC pipelines to the domestic refineries increased up to 14,116 thousand tons in 2013 compared to 13,980 thousand tons in 2012. Oil transportation to Atyrau Refinery amounted 4,333 thousand tons (no change compared to 2012), to Shymkent Refinery – 4,711 thousand tons (151 thousand tons increase), to Pavlodar Refinery – 5,047 thousand tons (55 thousand tons less), to Bitumen Plant – 25 thousand tons (the Plant was commissioned late December 2013).

The volume of oil transshipment to “Atasu-Alashankou” pipeline increased up to 11,828 thousand tons, which is 1,427 thousand tons or 14% higher than in 2012.

The volume of oil transportation by “Atyrau-Samara” section of “Uzen-Atyrau-Samara” pipeline in 2013 amounted 15,376 thousand tons (no change compared to 2012).

The volume of oil transshipment to the tankers at the Port of Aktau using the facilities of “KazTransOil” JSC amounted 5,995 thousand tons, which is 550 thousand tons or 8% less than in 2012.

The volume of oil transshipment to the CPC pipeline amounted 3,625 thousand tons, which is 343 thousand tons or 9% less than in 2012.

The volume of Russian oil transportation by Kazakhstani section of TON-2 pipeline made 6,533 thousand tons, which is 1,012 thousand tons or 18% higher than in 2012.

Oil turnover by “KazTransOil” JSC pipelines amounted 36,994 million tons per kilometer, which is 1,089 million tons per kilometer or 3% higher than the plan and 2,464 million tons per kilometer or 7% higher than in 2012.

The volume of fresh water supply to the customers of Atyrau and Mangistau regions of Kazakhstan via “Astrakhan-Mangyshlak” water pipeline made 23,390 thousand cubic meters, which is 591 thousand cubic meters or 3% higher than in 2012.
