Oil transportation through the Atyrau-Samara section of Uzen-Atyrau-Samara trunk pipeline has been restored

After stabilization of the electricity supply by the power transmission organization, on January 11, at 7.59pm oil transportation was resumed in the planned mode on Atyrau-Samara section of Uzen-Atyrau-Samara trunk pipeline.

Oil transportation through the system of main oil pipelines of “KazTransOil” JSC is carried out in the specified technological modes.

During the temporary suspension of oil transportation at Atyrau-Samara section due to the interruption of electricity supply (KEGOC JSC, Atyrau Zharyk JSC), there were no restrictions on the acceptance of oil from shippers.

The trunk pipeline "Uzen-Atyrau-Samara" with a length of 1235.7 km across the territory of Kazakhstan passes through the Mangistau, Atyrau and West Kazakhstan regions.

For reference:

“KazTransOil” JSC – the national operator of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the main oil pipeline. It is part of the “KazMunayGas” JSC Groups. It owns a diversified network of main oil pipelines with a length of 5.4 thousand km. Transports oil to Kazakhstan's refineries and for export in 5 directions: “Atyrau-Samara” and “Kazakhstan-China oil pipelines”, the port of Aktau (loading oil into tankers), transshipment to the CPC system, and the railway (loading into tanks). “KazTransOil” JSC's production facilities are located in Mangistau, Atyrau, West Kazakhstan, Aktobe, Pavlodar, Karaganda, Kyzylorda, Almaty, Turkestan, North Kazakhstan regions of Kazakhstan, Nur-Sultan and Shymkent.

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
