«KazTransOil» JSC delivered Kazakhstani oil to the system of Transneft PJSC oil pipelines for transit to Germany

On 25th February, «KazTransOil» JSC delivered 20 thousand tons of Kazakhstani oil to the system of «Transneft» PJSC oil pipelines in the direction of the «Adamova Zastava» oil delivery point for further transit to Germany.

In December 2022 «KazTransOil» JSC has sent an application for the transportation in 2023 of 1.2 million tons of Kazakh oil through the system of trunk oil pipelines of «Transneft» PJSC in the direction of the oil delivery point «Adamova Zastava» for further delivery to Germany. This transit of oil will be carried out within the framework of the relevant agreement between the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Government of the Russian Federation, dated June 7, 2002.

For reference:

KazTransOil JSC is the national operator of the main oil pipeline. It is part of the JSC NC "KazMunayGas" group. KazTransOil owns a diversified network of oil pipelines with a length of 5.4 thousand km. It transports oil to Kazakhstan refineries and exports oil in the following directions: Atyrau-Samara section of the Uzen-Atyrau-Samara trunk oil pipeline, transshipment into the Kazakh-Chinese Pipeline LLP system (Atasu-Alashankou oil pipeline), Aktau port (oil loading into tankers), transshipment into the Caspian Pipeline Consortium-K JSC system, filling oil into railway tanks at Shagyr and T. Kasymov oil loading stations.
