

Press release*Astana, April 09, 2024***In the first quarter of 2024, KazTransOil JSC transited 2 million 507 thousand tons of Russian oil to the People's Republic of China**

In the first quarter of 2024, KazTransOil JSC transited Russian oil to the People's Republic of China via the Atasu-Alashankou main oil pipeline in the amount of 2 million 507 thousand tons.

In 2023, the volume of transit of Russian oil through the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the People's Republic of China amounted to 9 million 989 thousand tons.

In 2014-2023, KazTransOil JSC provided the supply of 91 million tons of Russian oil through the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the People's Republic of China.

KazTransOil JSC has been transiting Russian oil through the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the People's Republic of China since 2014 under the agreement between the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Government of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of transporting Russian oil through the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the People's Republic of China dated December 24, 2013 .

In 2022, KazTransOil JSC extended the contract with Rosneft for the provision of services for the transportation of Russian oil through the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan to the People's Republic of China until December 31, 2033.

The Atasu-Alashankou main oil pipeline is part of the Kazakhstan-China main oil pipeline system and belongs to Kazakhstan-China Pipeline LLP, which is a joint venture of KazTransOil JSC (50%) and China National Oil and Gas Exploration and Development Company Ltd . (50 %). The design capacity of the main oil pipeline "Atasu - Alashankou" is 20 million tons of oil per year.

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
