“KazTransOil” JSC announces about the completion of work on the connection of three newly built sections of the “Uzen-Atyrau-Samara” trunk oil pipeline

“KazTransOil” JSC completed work on connecting to the “Uzen-Atyrau-Samara” trunk oil pipeline of two newly built sections with a total length of 22 kilometres and of the technological pipeline - inlet and outlet collectors of the oil heating station of the Beineu oil pumping station.

The sections of the “Uzen-Atyrau-Samara” oil pipeline 266.7-281.7 km and 283.7-290.7 km were replaced as part of the work to improve the reliability of the production infrastructure. Also, the inlet and outlet collectors of the oil heating station at the Beineu oil pumping station were replaced at 322.4 km of the trunk oil pipeline.

The work was carried out by 345 employees of the Mangistau, Kulsarinsky, Atyrau, Aktobe, Pavlodar and Karaganda oil pipeline departments, as well as employees of the Operations Department, the Main Dispatch Office of the Oil Transportation Center branch, the Department of Industrial Safety, Labour Protection and Emergency Situations of “KazTransOil” JSC and 108 units of special equipment. In addition, 61 employees and 14 units of special equipment of contractors were involved.

The operation of the “Uzen - Atyrau - Samara” oil pipeline at the section from Uzen OPS to the T. Kassymov OPS was suspended for 72 hours to enable the connection of new pipeline sections. All technical operations were completed on time in compliance with industrial safety and labour protection requirements.

Replacement of sections of the “Uzen - Atyrau - Samara” main oil pipeline was carried out as part of the implementation of the approved Investment Program of “KazTransOil” JSC for 2021-2025. The “Uzen - Atyrau - Samara” trunk oil pipeline is the second largest export rout of Kazakhstani oil to the world market. Oil is supplied through the “Uzen-Atyrau-Samara” pipeline and further through the PJSC Transneft system to the Baltic terminal of Ust-Luga and the Black Sea port of Novorossiysk. For 9 months of 2021, 9.3 million tons of oil were transported via the Uzen-Atyrau-Samara oil pipeline.

For reference:

“KazTransOil” JSC – the national operator of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the main oil pipeline. It is part of the “NC “KazMunayGas” Groups. It owns a diversified network of oil trunk pipelines with a length of 5.4 thousand km. It transports oil to Kazakhstan refineries and for export in the following directions: the “Atyrau-Samara” section of the “Uzen-Atyrau-Samara” trunk oil pipeline, transshipment to the “Kazakhstan-China Pipeline” LLP system (“Atasu-Alashankou” oil pipeline), the port of Aktau (oil loading into tankers), transshipment to the “Caspian Pipeline Consortium-K” JSC system, oil loading into railway tanks at the “Shagyr” Oil Refinery and the Oil Refinery Station n.a. T. Kassymov. Production facilities of “KazTransOil” JSC are located in Mangystau, Atyrau, West Kazakhstan, Aktobe, Pavlodar, Karaganda, Kyzylorda, Almaty, Turkestan, North Kazakhstan regions, Nur-Sultan and Shymkent.
