From November 1, the tariff of the subsidiary of KazTransOil JSC will change for water supply

On October 1, the Department of the Committee for Regulation of Natural Monopolies of the Ministry of National Economy of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the Atyrau Region declared invalid its order of August 2, 2024 on the cancellation of tariffs of Main Waterline LLP (100% of the shares belong to KazTransOil JSC) for the regulated service of water supply through main pipelines, approved by the order of the Department of the Committee for Regulation of Natural Monopolies of the Ministry of National Economy of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the Atyrau Region dated June 19, 2024.

At the same time, from November 1, 2024, in accordance with the order of the Department of the Committee for Regulation of Natural Monopolies of the Ministry of National Economy of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the Atyrau Region dated October 1, 2024, the average tariff of Main Waterline LLP for the regulated service of water supply through main pipelines is adjusted.

In particular, from November 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025, the average tariff will be 892.70 tenge / m³, having decreased by 43.18 tenge / m³; From July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026 - 917.86 tenge/m³, having decreased by 30.32 tenge/m³; From July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027 - 974.54 tenge/m³, having decreased by 30.33 tenge/m³; From July 1, 2027 to June 30, 2028 - 1,214.67 tenge/m³, having decreased by 30.32 tenge/m³; From July 1, 2028 to June 30, 2029 - 1,082.42 tenge/m³, having decreased by 30.33 tenge/m³.

KazTransOil JSC is the national operator of the main oil pipeline. It is part of the NC KazMunayGas JSC group. KazTransOil JSC owns a diversified network of main oil pipelines 5.4 thousand km in length.
