“KazTransOil” JSC announces about the completion of work on connection of 50 km section of the Astrakhan-Mangyshlak main water pipeline after reconstruction

“KazTransOil” JSC group of companies completed the connection of the newly built section at 449-499 km of the Astrakhan-Mangyshlak main water pipeline after reconstruction. Commissioning of a 50 km section of the water conduit was carried out by Kulsary, Mangystau and Atyrau oil pipeline departments of “KazTransOil” JSC. The reconstruction will increase the reliability of the pipeline network of the Astrakhan-Mangyshlak main water pipeline and ensure uninterrupted water supply for consumers in Atyrau and Mangystau regions.

In view of the prospective growth in the volume of water consumption in the western region of Kazakhstan, as well as in order to upgrade worn-out equipment, the “Main Waterline” LLP is implementing the "Reconstruction and expansion of the Astrakhan-Mangyshlak main water pipeline" investment project. As a result, the water pipeline capacity will increase to 170,000 cubic meters per day.

For reference:

“KazTransOil” JSC is the national operator of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the main oil pipeline. The Company is Included in the group of “NC “KazMunayGas” JSC. It owns a diversified network of main oil pipelines with a length of 5.4 thousand km.

“Main Waterline” LLP is a subsidiary of “KazTransOil” JSC. It provides services for the supply of water through the “Astrakhan-Mangyshlak” water pipeline with a total length of 1945.1 km. The route of “Astrakhan-Mangyshlak” main water pipeline passes through the territory of Atyrau and Mangystau regions. In 2021, 29,387,122 cubic meters of water were supplied to consumers.

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
