“KazTransOil” JSC announces about the commissioning after reconstruction of the “Prorva-Kulsary” main oil pipeline sections with a total length of 16 km

“KazTransOil” JSC has completed the connection of the newly constructed pipeline of the main oil pipeline “Prorva-Kulsary” on sections on 0-3 km, 21-33 km, 37-38 km with a total length of 16 km.

After the reconstruction, 191 employees of Atyrau, Pavlodar, Karaganda and Mangistau oil pipeline departments of “KazTransOil” JSC carried out work on the commissioning of sections of the main oil pipeline “Prorva-Kulsary”. 58 units of special equipment were involved.

This reconstruction of the pipeline of the main oil pipeline “Prorva – Kulsary” was realized in the framework of the project «Capital repair with the replacement of the pipeline “Prorva-Kulsary” on sections 0-3 km, 4-6 km, 9-12 km, 13-15 km, 21-33 km, 37-38 km, 39-43 km, 46-50 km, 60-64 km, 73-76 km, 90-95 km, 100-101 km with start-up camera of cleaning and diagnostics means» (1st and 2nd line).

The main oil pipeline “Prorva-Kulsary” was put into operation in 1986, connected to the main oil pipeline «Ozen - Atyrau – Samara” for transportation of oil fields Atyrau region for export and the internal market. It has a length of 103 km, a design capacity of 7.01 million tons of oil per year, and an actual capacity of 3.4 million tons of oil per year.

For reference:

“KazTransOil” JSC – the national operator of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the main oil pipeline. It is part of the “NC “KazMunayGas” Groups. It owns a diversified network of oil trunk pipelines with a length of 5.4 thousand km. It transports oil to Kazakhstan refineries and for export in the following directions: the “Atyrau-Samara” section of the “Uzen-Atyrau-Samara” trunk oil pipeline, transshipment to the “Kazakhstan-China Pipeline” LLP system (“Atasu-Alashankou” oil pipeline), the port of Aktau (oil loading into tankers), transshipment to the “Caspian Pipeline Consortium-K” JSC system, oil loading into railway tanks at the “Shagyr” Oil Refinery and the Oil Refinery Station n.a. T. Kasymov. Production facilities of “KazTransOil” JSC are located in Mangystau, Atyrau, West Kazakhstan, Aktobe, Pavlodar, Karaganda, Kyzylorda, Almaty, Turkestan, North Kazakhstan regions, Nur-Sultan and Shymkent.

“KazTransOil” JSC non-consolidated net profit for the 1st half of 2021 made KZT 26,931.5 million, which is by 23% lower than the result for the 1st half of 2020.
