From January 1, 2025 export transportation tariffs of KazTransOil JSC will increase

In order to ensure reliable transportation of oil KazTransOil JSC will increase the tariff for oil transportation service through main pipelines for export outside the Republic of Kazakhstan by 1,150 tenge to 11,300 tenge per 1 ton per 1,000 km (excluding VAT) from January 1, 2025.

In addition, from January 1, 2025, the tariffs of KazTransOil JSC for additional services for oil transportation through main pipelines for export outside the Republic of Kazakhstan will change.

In particular, tariff for the service of oil transshipment at the Makat oil pumping station to the Kenkiyak - Atyrau oil pipeline will be 2,436 tenge per 1 ton (excluding VAT), increasing by 152.73 tenge.

Tariff for oil transshipment service at the Kenkiyak head oil pumping station will amount to 740 tenge per 1 ton (excluding VAT), increasing by 402.5 tenge.

Tariff for oil transshipment service at the Atasu head oil pumping station to the Atasu - Alashankou oil pipeline will be 380 tenge per 1 ton (excluding VAT), increasing by 93.87 tenge.

For reference:

KazTransOil JSC is the national operator of the main oil pipeline. It is part of the group of NC KazMunaiGas JSC and owns a diversified network of main oil pipelines spanning 5.4 thousand km, while also providing operator services for the maintenance of third-party pipelines totaling more than 5 thousand km in length.

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
