

Press release*Astana, September 4, 2026***KazTransOil launches first transit oil supplies to Kyrgyzstan**

The first shipment of crude oil to Kyrgyzstan was dispatched on August 15, 2026. In total, 35,000 tonnes of crude oil were transported in transit through Kazakhstan to Kyrgyzstan in August 2026.

Crude oil deliveries to Kyrgyzstan are carried out through KazTransOil’s trunk oil pipeline system to the Shagyr oil loading point, where the crude oil is loaded into railway tank cars.

The launch of transit supplies to Kyrgyzstan establishes a new crude oil transportation route through Kazakhstan and expands the range of transit services provided by KazTransOil.

KazTransOil JSC is the national operator of the main oil pipeline system. It is a subsidiary of KazMunayGas NC JSC. The company owns a diversified network of main oil pipelines with a total length of 5,200 km and provides pipeline operation services for third-party organizations, covering an additional 5,000 km of pipelines.
