

Press release*Astana, September 9, 2026***KazTransOil increases oil transportation volumes in the first eight months of 2026**

The consolidated volume of oil transportation and petroleum products transshipment by KazTransOil JSC amounted to 31.890 million tonnes in the first eight months of 2026, an increase of 4% compared with the same period in 2025.

Separately, 30.639 million tonnes of oil were transported through the KazTransOil JSC trunk oil pipeline system, 4% more than in the first eight months of 2025.

In the reporting period, KazTransOil JSC’s consolidated oil freight turnover amounted to 30.546 billion tonne-kilometres, up 2% year-on-year.

Oil freight turnover through the KazTransOil JSC trunk oil pipeline system amounted to 23.696 billion tonne-kilometres, an increase of 1% compared with the same period in 2025.

The volume of oil transported through the KazTransOil JSC trunk oil pipeline system to Kazakhstan’s oil refineries amounted to 12.087 million tonnes, including:

- 3.567 million tonnes delivered to Atyrau Refinery LLP;
- 3.664 million tonnes delivered to PetroKazakhstan Oil Products LLP;
- 4.316 million tonnes delivered to Pavlodar Petrochemical Plant LLP;
- 540 thousand tonnes of oil delivered to JV CASPI BITUM LLP.

In the reporting period, the volume of oil transported through the Atyrau–Samara section of the Uzen–Atyrau–Samara trunk oil pipeline amounted to 6.922 million tonnes, up 2% compared with the same period in 2025.

A total of 8.145 million tonnes of oil was transported through the TON-2 pipeline section in the first eight months of 2026, representing a 5% increase year-on-year.

The volume of oil transshipped into the Atasu–Alashankou trunk oil pipeline amounted to 7.602 million tonnes, up 3% compared with 2025. Of this volume, 863 thousand tonnes represented exports of Kazakh oil through this route, an increase of 24% compared with the same period last year.

The volume of oil transshipped into the system of Caspian Pipeline Consortium-K JSC amounted to 3.123 million tonnes, up 39% compared with 2025.

The volume of oil loaded onto tankers at the Port of Aktau using KazTransOil JSC’s facilities amounted to 2.384 million tonnes, an increase of 6% compared with the same period in 2025. In particular, oil transshipment in the Baku–Tbilisi–Ceyhan direction increased by 12% to 1.034 million tonnes.

A total of 13.121 million tonnes of oil was transported through the pipeline systems of Kazakhstan–China Pipeline LLP, an increase of 2% compared with the same period in 2025. Oil freight turnover amounted to 11.879 billion tonne-kilometres, up 3% year-on-year.

The volume of oil transported through the pipeline of North-Western Transportation Company MunaiTas LLP amounted to 4.302 million tonnes, 10% more than in the same period of 2025. Oil freight turnover increased by 8% year-on-year to 1.784 billion tonne-kilometres.

For the Batumi Oil Terminal LLC group of companies, the volume of oil, petroleum products and gas transshipment amounted to 1.251 million tonnes, 4% more than in the first eight months of 2025.

Through the Astrakhan–Mangyshlak trunk water pipeline, Magistralny Vodovod LLP supplied 16.461 million cubic metres of fresh water to consumers in the Atyrau and Mangystau regions.

KazTransOil JSC is Kazakhstan's national oil pipeline operator and a member of the KazMunayGas group of companies. The Company operates a diversified network of more than 5,200 kilometres of main oil pipelines and provides operation and maintenance services for third-party pipeline systems with a total length exceeding 5,000 kilometres.

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
