

Press release*Astana, April 15, 2025***KazTransOil JSC reports operating results for the first quarter of 2026**

KazTransOil JSC has announced its operating results for the first quarter of 2026.

During the reporting period, the consolidated volume of oil transportation and petroleum products transshipment amounted to 11.947 million tons, which is 705 thousand tons higher than in the first quarter of 2025.

Separately, 11.744 million tons of oil were transported through the trunk pipeline system of KazTransOil JSC, which is 833 thousand tons more than in the same period of 2025.

The company’s consolidated oil cargo turnover in Q1 2026 totaled 11.232 billion ton-kilometers, an increase of 36 million ton-kilometers compared with the first quarter of 2025.

Oil cargo turnover through the trunk pipeline system of KazTransOil JSC alone amounted to 8.635 billion ton-kilometers.

The volume of oil supplied via KazTransOil JSC’s trunk pipeline system to the refineries of the Republic of Kazakhstan reached 4.412 million tons, including:

- 1.458 million tons to Atyrau Oil Refinery LLP;
- 1.323 million tons to PetroKazakhstan Oil Products LLP;
- 1.591 million tons to Pavlodar Petrochemical Plant LLP;
- 40 thousand tons to СП “CASPI BITUM” LLP.

In the first quarter of 2026, oil transportation through the Atyrau-Samara section of the Uzen–Atyrau–Samara trunk pipeline totaled 2.621 million tons, which is 212 thousand tons more than in the same period of 2025.

Of this volume, supplies of Kazakh oil to the pipeline system of Transneft PJSC for onward delivery to Germany increased by 353 thousand tons year-on-year and amounted to 730 thousand tons.

Through the TON-2 pipeline section, 2.867 million tons of oil were transported in Q1 2026, which is 58 thousand tons less than in the same period of last year.

A total of 2.850 million tons of oil was transshipped into the Atasu-Alashankou trunk pipeline, exceeding the Q1 2025 figure by 129 thousand tons. Of this, exports of Kazakh oil in this direction amounted to 345 thousand tons, up 106 thousand tons year-on-year.

The volume of oil transshipment into the system of Caspian Pipeline Consortium-K JSC totaled 1.331 million tons, which is 427 thousand tons higher than in the first quarter of 2025.

Oil loading into tankers at the Port of Aktau using KazTransOil JSC facilities amounted to 853 thousand tons, which is 35 thousand tons more than in Q1 2025. This included 346 thousand tons transshipped in the Baku–Tbilisi–Ceyhan direction, up 26 thousand tons year-on-year.



During the reporting period, 4.953 million tons of oil were transported through the pipeline system of Kazakhstan-China Pipeline LLP, which is 106 thousand tons more than in the same period of 2025. The company’s cargo turnover amounted to 4.514 billion ton-kilometers.

Through the pipeline system of MunaiTas NWPC LLP, 1.608 million tons of oil were transported, which is 129 thousand tons more than in the first quarter of 2025. The company’s cargo turnover increased by 31 million ton-kilometers to 666 million ton-kilometers.

Across the Batumi Oil Terminal LLC group of companies and Petrotrans Limited, the volume of oil and petroleum products transshipment during the reporting period totaled 203 thousand tons.

Main Waterline LLP supplied 5.390 million cubic meters of fresh water to consumers in Kazakhstan’s Atyrau and Mangystau regions via the Astrakhan–Mangyshlak water pipeline, which remained at the level of the same period in 2025.

KazTransOil JSC is the national operator of the Republic of Kazakhstan for the main oil pipeline. It is part of the NC KazMunayGas JSC group. It owns a diversified network of main oil pipelines with a length of 5.2 thousand km and provides operator services for the maintenance of pipelines of third-party organizations with a total length of more than 5 thousand km.
