

Press release*Astana, July 15, 2026***KazTransOil JSC reports increased oil transportation volume for the first half of 2026**

KazTransOil JSC has announced its operating results for the first half of 2026.

During the reporting period, the Company transported 22.911 million tonnes of oil through its mainline pipeline system, up 643 thousand tonnes compared with the corresponding period of 2025.

The consolidated oil transportation and petroleum products transshipment volume across the KazTransOil Group reached 23.636 million tonnes, an increase of 562 thousand tonnes year-on-year.

A total of 8.806 million tonnes of oil was delivered through the KazTransOil mainline pipeline system to Kazakhstan's refineries, including:

- Atyrau Oil Refinery LLP – 2.766 million tonnes;
- PetroKazakhstan Oil Products LLP – 2.533 million tonnes;
- Pavlodar Petrochemical Plant LLP – 3.197 million tonnes;
- CASPI BITUM LLP – 310 thousand tonnes.

Oil transportation via the Atyrau–Samara section of the Uzen–Atyrau–Samara main oil pipeline totalled 5.095 million tonnes, exceeding the figure for the corresponding period of last year by 42 thousand tonnes.

A total of 5.885 million tonnes of oil was transported through the Kazakhstan section of the TON-2 pipeline, an increase of 38 thousand tonnes compared with the first half of 2025.

A total of 5.702 million tonnes of oil was transferred into the Atasu–Alashankou main oil pipeline, an increase of 236 thousand tonnes compared with the corresponding period of the previous year.

Oil transferred into the Caspian Pipeline Consortium-K JSC (CPC-K) system totalled 2.524 million tonnes, up 725 thousand tonnes compared with the first half of 2025.

Through KazTransOil's loading facilities at the Port of Aktau, 1.713 million tonnes of oil were loaded onto tankers, including 704 thousand tonnes shipped towards the Baku–Tbilisi–Ceyhan (BTC) pipeline.

Oil throughput, measured in tonne-kilometres, totalled 17.337 billion tonne-kilometres through the KazTransOil mainline pipeline system, while consolidated oil throughput across the Group reached 22.429 billion tonne-kilometres.

Across the Batumi Oil Terminal Group LLC, the transshipment volume of crude oil, petroleum products and gas totalled 725 thousand tonnes. Overall cargo transshipment reached 4.008 million tonnes, up 324 thousand tonnes compared with the first half of 2025.

Through the pipeline system of Kazakhstan-China Pipeline LLP, 9.757 million tonnes of oil were transported, an increase of 149 thousand tonnes compared with the corresponding period of 2025. Oil throughput reached 8.840 billion tonne-kilometres, up 257 million tonne-kilometres year-on-year.

Through the MunaiTas North-West Pipeline Company LLP pipeline, 3.183 million tonnes of oil were transported, an increase of 273 thousand tonnes compared with the corresponding period of the previous year. Oil throughput reached 1.316 billion tonne-kilometres, up 72 million tonne-kilometres compared with the first half of 2025.

Via the Astrakhan–Mangyshlak main water pipeline, operated by Main Waterline LLP, 11.365 million cubic metres of fresh water were supplied to consumers in the Atyrau and Mangystau regions.

KazTransOil JSC continues to ensure reliable oil transportation, support the development of Kazakhstan's export routes and enhance the operational performance of its group of companies through the consistent implementation of strategic initiatives focused on sustainable development, operational efficiency and asset reliability.

KazTransOil JSC is Kazakhstan's national oil pipeline operator and a member of the KazMunayGas group of companies. The Company operates a diversified network of more than 5,200 kilometres of main oil pipelines and provides operation and maintenance services for third-party pipeline systems with a total length exceeding 5,000 kilometres.

KazTransOil JSC owns a 100% interest in Main Waterline LLP, which owns and operates the Astrakhan–Mangyshlak main water pipeline.

Batumi Oil Terminal LLC (BOT) is a wholly owned subsidiary of KazTransOil JSC. Through BOT, the Company owns and manages its operating assets in Georgia.

Petrotrans Limited (PTL) is a wholly owned subsidiary of KazTransOil JSC. PTL provides freight forwarding services along the Transcaucasian corridor, delivers transportation services from the Caspian region via Georgia and carries out commercial and operational activities related to the transportation of crude oil and petroleum products.

Kazakhstan-China Pipeline LLP is a joint venture owned by KazTransOil JSC (50%) and China National Oil and Gas Exploration and Development Company Ltd. (50%). The company owns and operates the Kenkiyak–Kumkol and Atasu–Alashankou main oil pipelines.

MunaiTas North-West Pipeline Company LLP is a joint venture owned by KazTransOil JSC (51%) and CNPC Exploration and Development Company Ltd. (49%), established to design, finance, construct and operate the Kenkiyak–Atyrau main oil pipeline.

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
