KazTransOil connects newly constructed section of the Pavlodar– POCR oil pipeline

To ensure reliable oil transportation from the Pavlodar Head Oil Pumping Station to Pavlodar Oil Chemistry Refinery LLP (POCR), KazTransOil JSC has completed the construction and connection of a 580-metre section of the pipeline. The project is aimed at ensuring reliable oil supplies to POCR, maintaining a stable feedstock supply for the plant’s operations, and supporting the further processing of crude oil into petroleum products.

The connection works were carried out by 75 employees of KazTransOil’s Pavlodar and Karaganda Oil Pipeline Departments, using 28 units of motor vehicles and specialized equipment.

In support of domestic manufacturing, pipes produced by Qarmet Tubular Products Aktau LLP, a Kazakh company, were used for the construction. The 820 mm-diameter pipes with a 12 mm wall thickness, installed within a protective casing, feature a factory-applied enhanced external three-layer polyethylene coating. The coating provides additional protection against external factors and extends the service life of the pipeline section.

The 820 mm-diameter «Pavlodar– Pavlodar Oil Chemistry Refinery» main oil pipeline was commissioned in 1977. Its modernization enhances the reliability and supports the sustainable operation of KazTransOil’s oil transportation infrastructure, ensuring stable crude oil supplies to a domestic oil refinery.

KazTransOil JSC is Kazakhstan's national oil pipeline operator and a member of the KazMunayGas group of companies. The Company operates a diversified network of more than 5,200 kilometres of main oil pipelines and provides operation and maintenance services for third-party pipeline systems with a total length exceeding 5,000 kilometres.

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
