KazTransOil completes reconstruction of tank at T. Kassymov oil pumping station

KazTransOil JSC has completed the reconstruction of Tank No. 7, with a capacity of 20,000 cubic metres, at the T. Kassymov Oil Pumping Station. The tank is used for receiving, storing and carrying out technological operations with crude oil.

As part of the reconstruction, a comprehensive set of technical measures was implemented to enhance the reliability, industrial safety and environmental performance of the facility. In particular, the tank has been equipped with a modern floating roof, which significantly reduces atmospheric emissions of pollutants.

The reconstruction also included the replacement of electrochemical corrosion protection equipment, instrumentation and control systems. Modern anti-corrosion coatings were applied to the tank's internal and external surfaces, providing reliable protection of the metal structures against corrosion and helping to extend their service life.

The commissioning of the reconstructed tank strengthens the reliability of the station's tank farm, improves the efficiency of existing capacity utilisation and enhances the safety of oil-handling operations.

Following the completion of the reconstruction of Tank No. 7, the total capacity of the tank farm at the T. Kassymov Oil Pumping Station has reached 230,000 cubic metres.

The T. Kassymov Oil Pumping Station, operated by the Atyrau Oil Pipeline Division of KazTransOil JSC, is located at kilometre 700.4 of the Uzen–Atyrau–Samara main oil pipeline.

The reconstruction of the tank farm is part of KazTransOil JSC's systematic efforts to modernise its production infrastructure. Under the Company's 2024–2028 tank farm modernisation programme, measures are planned for 29 tanks with a total capacity of 500,000 cubic metres. Of this capacity, 140,000 cubic metres will be covered by reconstruction, 180,000 cubic metres by the construction of new tanks, and 180,000 cubic metres by restoration.

The modernisation and expansion of tank storage capacity are aimed at developing modern, reliable and environmentally responsible oil transportation infrastructure at KazTransOil JSC.

KazTransOil JSC is Kazakhstan's national oil pipeline operator and a member of the KazMunayGas group of companies. The Company operates a diversified network of more than 5,200 kilometres of main oil pipelines and provides operation and maintenance services for third-party pipeline systems with a total length exceeding 5,000 kilometres.

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
